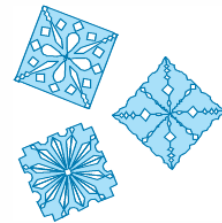


## A Blizzard of Good Work

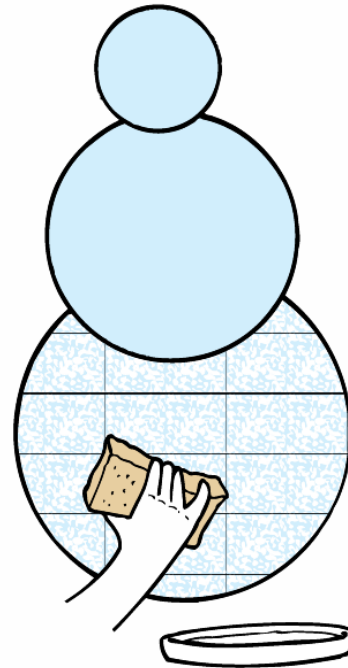
### Materials

- background—dark blue butcher paper
- snowman:
  - light blue butcher paper
  - buttons—yellow construction paper
  - scarf—red construction paper
  - nose—orange construction paper
  - hat and eyes—black construction paper
  - arms—thin twigs
- white tempera paint and sponge
- snowflakes:
  - white construction paper squares
- construction paper for mounting student work
- cutouts:
  - caption letters on pages 173, 175, and 177, laminated and trimmed



### Steps to Follow

1. Cover the bulletin board area with dark blue butcher paper.
2. Build the snowman:
  - Cut the three snowballs from light blue paper and sponge paint them using the white tempera paint. Let the shapes dry completely.
  - Pin the shapes to the board.
  - Add the scarf, hat, carrot nose, eyes, and buttons cut from construction paper as shown.
  - Pin the twig arms in place.
3. Make snowflakes and pin them across the bottom of the board and around the snowman. Follow the folding and cutting steps shown on page 33.
4. Add the caption.
5. Post student work on the construction paper.
